

RACING PIGEON FEEDING CALENDAR

RESTING SEASON

SEPTEMBER TO END OF OCTOBER

During this resting period a carbohydrate mix is preferable as lower energy and protein levels are required. The purpose of this is to keep the birds lean and prevent the build up of impurities in the body. Use high percentages of Wheat & Barley.

Recommended Products to use: **DEPURATIVE**

WINTER ECONOMY MIX



MOULTING SEASON

NOVEMBER TO JANUARY

During this period reduce carbohydrates and increase protein until moult is completed.

Recommended Products to use: **MOULTING MIX**



BREEDING SEASON

FEBRUARY TO MAY

During this period use a high protein mix.

Recommended Products to use:

RACING SEASON

APRIL TO SEPTEMBER



SPRINT RACING

60 to 120 miles

Emphasis on a higher percentage of carbohydrates.

MIDDLE DISTANCE

120 to 300 miles
